



RULES OF MEMBERSHIP

House rules

1. The name of the establishment is 'No.41', Its address 41 Conduit Street, Mayfair, London, W1S 2YQ.
2. The proprietor of No.41 Club is the Westbury Hotel. The Westbury Hotel gives the right of 'rules' to Club No.41 in accordance with premises license and UK Law. The 'rules' are created by Club No.41 and must be adhered to all times.
3. It shall provide and maintain Club premises of the highest quality and staff of the highest caliber for the comfort of members.
4. The membership committee is composed by The General Manager and Managers.

MEMBERSHIP

1. Any person aged 21 or over is eligible for membership
2. A person shall become a member of the Club if elected by the Membership committee.
3. The Membership committee shall have the right to refuse any member entrance to the Club at any time.
4. Every member of the Club shall, subject to these Rules and upon payment of any charges fixed by the Club, be entitled to use and enjoy, in common with the other members of the Club, the Club premises and the things therein provided by the Club for the use of the Club.
5. A successful applicant will be given immediate notice of his election and shall become a member of the Club and be entitled to all the benefits and privileges of such membership and agrees thereby to be found to be bound by these Rules.
6. A hard copy of these Rules will also be placed in the Club reception at all the times.
7. All membership fees, subscriptions and payments by members become the property of the Company. The Company shall be solely responsible for the provision of the Club premises and all services necessary for carrying on the Club and shall have entire control of all financial matters connected with the Club. Member's liability shall only arise as a result of membership and shall be for such payments to the Secretary as are provided by these Rules.
8. The Company may, as its complete discretion, invite persons to become Honorary and Ambassador Members. Honorary and Ambassador Memberships may be ended by the Company at any time at its complete discretion at any time.
9. The Club shall have an absolute discretion as to whether a person shall remain a member of the Club and shall have the right to expel or terminate the membership of any member for any reason without giving any explanation.
10. Members are entitled to bring 5 guests. For any extra guests a Guest list is available.
11. Members are responsible for their guest's charges if they fail to settle their account.
12. The introducing member shall be responsible for his guests strictly adhering to the Club Rules.
13. Any decision under these Rules shall be conclusive and binding. It is a term and condition of membership that no legal proceedings shall be instituted by any member to challenge the ruling of the Club.
14. These Rules shall be governed by and constructed in accordance with English Law[refer to law].Members and any guests of members irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts in respect of any disputes arising in connection with membership of the Club, or otherwise howsoever.
15. Nothing in the foregoing however shall prevent The Club No.41 from instituting legal proceedings in any other jurisdiction as it sees fit, and in those circumstances members and any guests or members irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the court in question.
16. If a member or guest's behavior is deemed unacceptable as a result of becoming intoxicated off the premises the Club may take any action it deems reasonable, including but not limited to, refusing entry, requesting the member and/or the guest to leave the premises or withdrawing the member's membership.
17. No credit shall be given, provided or facilitated to any person, unless authorized by the Club.
18. All property brought into the Club premises by any member or his guest shall be at the sole risk of the person bringing such property onto the Club premises and neither the 'Company' nor any employee of the Company shall be liable for any loss or damage to any such article, howsoever occasioned.
19. Neither the Club nor any employee of the Club shall, under any circumstances, be responsible to members of their guests for loss or damage to vehicles parked, collected or driven by staff of the Club, or loss of or damage to the contents or accessories or in any such vehicle.
20. The Club may, from time to time, revoke, alter or add to these Rules. Any such revocation, alteration or addition shall be deemed to have been brought to the attention of members provided a notice of any changes is prominently displayed to members within the Club.

21. No member shall remove or damage or destroy any picture, item of furniture, or other article being the property of the Company. Any member will be fully responsible for making good loss suffered by the Club or Company as a result damage or destruction.

EXHIBITIONS AND CLUB EVENTS

1. On the occasion of any pre - organized exhibition or event, No.41 may determine that on certain days members may not be admitted to the Club.
2. The Company reserves the right to shut off any portion of the Club premises at any time, to exclude members there from and to close the Club from time to time as it may deem necessary.

FEES AND SUBSCRIPTION

1. Membership £500 for the year.
2. Overseas Membership £300 for the year.
3. Corporate Membership for 10 people £3,000 for the year
4. If a Member, having paid the subscription in advance for the year, shall for any reason cease to be a Member before the expiry of that year, he shall not be entitled to be reimbursed any part of that annual subscription.

BOOKINGS

1. All table reservations must be made through the office in advance of the required date.
2. All bookings and cancellations for Club events, private parties and business events must be made through the office in advance of the required date.

MEMBERS' ADDRESSES

Every member of the Club shall notify any change of address to the membership committee and all notices posted to the last notified address of the member shall be considering as having been duly given and received on the seventh day following posting. All members' details are kept in accordance with date protection Act. or will not be given to 3rd parties.

COMPLAINTS

1. All complaints shall be made in writing to the General Manager
2. A member shall not personally reprimand a member of Club staff.

OPENING HOURS

Club Hours

- Thursday and Friday the Club opens at 10pm and closes at 3.00am.
- Saturday the club opens at 11pm and closes at 3.00am

Office Hours

- The office is open Monday to Friday from 10am to 6pm.

DRESSCODE

1. All Members, and guests must be smartly dressed. No hats or trainers will be allowed. Final discretion will be made at the door.
2. All coats, bags and briefcases are not permitted in the Club, and must be placed in the provided cloakroom facility in the permitted hours of operation,
